## Travel Restrictions

Per Montana State Governor's directive from March, 30th, 2020 Effective through April 24th, 2020 unless announced otherwise or extended



 Any person coming to Montana from another state or country for a non-work-related purpose must immediately self-quarantine for 14 days.

If a person will be present in Montana for fewer than 14 days, that person must self-quarantine for the duration of the visit.

 If you live in Montana and leave the state, even if just across the border, you will have to self-quarantine upon return for 14 days.

If you can't self-quarantine for 14 days, please return to your home state.
