Instructions for Carbon County Community COVID-19 Testing Event



We encourage everyone to wear a mask to this event.

Approach from the **south** end of the parking lot on Chambers Avenue. Use 5th Street to access Chambers Ave. Please follow the directions of traffic control personnel and signs. Exit will be at the North end of the parking lot.

When you reach the parking lot, follow the instructions of the Traffic Control Guide. They will give you a lane assignment.

When you get to the testing station, please follow the instructions of the provider.

They will ask:

- 1. Your name, date of birth, physical address, phone number and Primary Care provider name
- 2. About any symptoms you may have
- Parent/Guardians of children under 18 will have to sign a consent form

These questions will be repeated for everyone in the car to be tested.

To make the process faster, please download and fill in this form and hand it to the nurse

For individuals under 18 to be tested, please have a parent or guardian fill and sign the consent information as well.

You do not need an ID or insurance card

Your information will be kept by Public Health in case there is a need for follow up. It will not be shared.

The provider will then:

- 1. Hand you a testing swab
- 2. Instruct you to swab the inside of your nose with the swab
- 3. Have you place the swab in the testing vial
- 4. Repeat this procedure for all individuals in the car to be tested

Once the provider tells you the testing is complete, please exit the parking lot carefully and follow the instructions of the Traffic Control Guide.

Testing results should be available in 2-3 days.

You will only be notified if your test is positive so that confirmation testing can be performed.

We will communicate when all testing results are in. If you have not been contacted at that point, you may assume your test result is negative.

If you are **sick** with any of the following symptoms, please call Beartooth Hospital at 406-446-2345 to arrange drive-through testing at that facility.
