UPDATE ON CURRENT CONDITIONS IN THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES 6/13/22 1900 HRS

Rock Creek in the Joliet area, and the Clarks Fork of the Yellowstone River near Fromberg are expected to crest at midnight tonight. Rock Creek in Red Lodge crested at approximately noon Monday 6/13.

Evacuation shelters are located at Fromberg School, Bridger School, and the Red Lodge Fairgrounds.

Current evacuation orders in effect:

Red Lodge: East Side Road south of Red Lodge; the area east of Broadway from 19th Street to 16th Street, Park Avenue, South Kainu Avenue, Island at Rock Creek – Kainu; and structures on the east side of Adams Avenue south of 19th Street, and west of Highway 212. Belfry: Lover's Lane.

Fromberg: All areas east of Highway 310, south of East River Road west of the river.

No evacuation orders are in effect for the Joliet area at this time.

All drinking water from the tap should be boiled before use in Red Lodge and Fromberg. See our previous post for more info on this.

Cajun Phatty's will have a food truck at Bridger School offering evacuees free meals Wednesday: dinner; Thursday: breakfast, lunch and dinner; Friday: breakfast and Lunch.
